

# FUNDING OPTIONS AT LITTLE BARN OWLS

A guide to help families understand the funding options at LBO

### **GOVERNMENT FUNDING**



#### How is Government Funding Applied Throughout the Year?

The government offers up to 30 funded hours per week, but to ensure year-round support, this funding is stretched over 51 weeks. This means families can claim up to 22 hours per week instead of 30, ensuring a consistent allocation of childcare hours across the full nursery year.

#### Who is Eligible for Funded Nursery Places?

- 9 months to 3 years: Eligible children can receive 11 funded hours per week if they meet government criteria.
- 3 to 5 years: Eligible children can receive 22 funded hours per week
- All 3- and 4-year-olds are entitled to 11 hours per week, regardless of eligibility.

#### **Changes from September 2025**

- All children aged 9 months to 4 years can access up to 22 funded hours if parents meet eligibility criteria.
- Some 2-year-olds can receive 11 hours if parents claim certain benefits.
- All 3- and 4-year-olds continue to receive up to 11 hours, regardless of eligibility.

This expansion ensures more families have access to affordable early years education.

## CHANGES TO GOVERNMENT FUNDING

From <u>April 2025</u>, the government is changing how Free Entitlement (EYFE) hours are offered in childcare settings. In some cases, the government funding rate per hour is significantly lower than our operating costs. Whilst we fully support the government's intention to help parents access more affordable childcare, these changes mean it is no longer viable for us to continue offering the high-quality care and education, experiences, and resources that children deserve with the government funding available. As such, and through necessity, we are introducing a two tiered funding option:

Your Funding Options:

- 1.Full Package Includes funded hours plus access to enriching experiences, high-quality resources, outings, and enhanced learning opportunities.
- 2.EYFE-Only Package A fully government-funded option covering core care and learning, but without access to additional activities, resources, and consumables.

## EYFE ONLY PACKAGE



Our EYFE-only Package is covered entirely by government funding and allows families to use up to 11 or 22 hours of funded entitlement per week (15 or 30 hours spread across 51 weeks of the year). This package includes:

Standard Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) provision

A safe and nurturing environment

Engaging activities that support early development

Basic Learning Journal

This package does not include our LBO Enhanced Provision. EYFE-only bookings do not include:

Meals, snacks, nappies, sun cream

Farm School

Forest School

Atelier sessions with Artist in Residence

Enriched provision (experiences beyond the EYFS - see Full Package details)

Special Events and Ceremonies (Graduation, Parent Events, Seasonal Events)

Advanced Learning Journal, Documentation and Project Shares

The Full Package is carefully priced at £26 per funded day, covering all the additional benefits your child will receive:

## EYFE-only details

The EYFE-only Package ensures quality early education, but does not provide the additional opportunities that enhance your child's learning journey.

As per LBO Policies and Procedures, Ts&Cs, and Health and Safety Guidance, children are not permitted to bring any food from home into the nursery. As such, there will be an optional\* <u>£10 Meals Service</u> charge applied per day for EYFE-only children to cover all meals and snacks.

\*Those who do not wish to pay the charge are welcome to collect and feed their children outside of the nursery at lunchtime.

Parents will not be permitted to pay for extra hours on the EYFE-only Package. Those who wish to attend more than the EYFE-only hours will automatically be enrolled in The Full Package.

Parents will be required to provide all consumables daily, packed into the child's bag. This MUST include: Sun cream Nappies (where needed) Wet wipes Nappy sacks Nappy creams

In the event of items being forgotten, 'Emergency Consumables Charges' will apply.

Parents will be responsible for covering the costs of extra-curricular activities.

Parents will be responsible for covering some or all of the cost of trips and outings.
