Early Years Funded Entitlement - Key points for parents.

- All settings who deliver care all year round (51 weeks or more) are permitted to offer 'stretched funded hours' to parents which means we are able to offer up to 22 hours a week each week of the year over a number of days or sessions a child attends nursery. This is the equivalent of 30 hours a week term time (which is 38 weeks of the year).
- EYFE is limited to 11 hours per week (over 51 weeks of the year), equivalent to 15 hours per week (over 38 weeks of the year) for the following groups:
 - 2-year-old children with an LA-issued code (i.e. where parents are accessing certain government benefits);
 - children over 3-years-old who do not meet the government's 'working parents' eligibility criteria.
- The government's Early Years Funding covers the delivery of the statutory Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS). All children at Little Barn Owls receive the full EYFS curriculum and care. Many parents choose our full package, which includes a wider range of enriched experiences and services beyond the EYFS requirements, however these elements are not covered by the funded entitlement and therefore incur an Additional Services Charge.
- Additional services include (but not limited to): Food (meals and snacks), Hygiene products (Nappies, wipes etc.), Forest provision, Farm school provision, Artistry sessions, Suncream. See the [Funding Options Booklet](#) for a full breakdown of the additional services charge.
- Any funded hours not being used at Little Barn Owls, can be used at other childcare settings. If you want to split your child's funding entitlement, please email our funding team – funding@littlebarnowls.co.uk
- Little Barn Owls offers a range of funded delivery patterns to support family needs. All funded patterns meet the requirements of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS).
- Patterns offered may differ slightly between nurseries and are subject to availability. Please contact the admissions team to check current availability.

Additional Funding Entitlements

EYPP

The Early Years Pupil Premium (EYPP) is additional funding for early years settings to improve the education they provide for eligible children. The aim of the EYPP is to close the gap between children from disadvantaged backgrounds and their peers by providing funding to early years providers to help them raise the quality of their provision. For Little Barn Owls to apply for EYPP (using economic criteria), parents need to supply their details (Name, DOB, NI number or NASS number) on the Parent Declaration Form. The Local Authority (WSCC) will check eligibility as part of the termly funding application process and apply EYPP where appropriate. Please note that no information about parent's finances or income are shared by the DWP when they check eligibility.

EYPP can also be awarded on the basis of non-economic criteria. You may get EYPP if your child is currently being looked after by a local authority in England or Wales or if your child has left care in England or Wales through: adoption; a special guardianship order; or a child arrangements order. If any of these apply, please indicate this on your Parent Declaration Form.

DAF

The Disability Access Fund (DAF) is a funding entitlement which aids access to early years places by, for example, supporting providers in making adjustments to their settings. Children will be eligible for DAF if the child meets both of the following criteria:

- is in receipt of child Disability Living Allowance (DLA) and
- receives or is due to receive any Early Years Funded Entitlement.

In order for Little Barn Owls to apply for DAF, the parent must indicate that they are eligible on their Parent Declaration Form, and they must provide some recent evidence that they are in receipt of DLA (for example, a letter from the DWP).

For any children in receipt of EYPP or DAF, our Head of Family Support and Lead SENCO will assess the child's specific needs (which may be done in conjunction with discussions with their family) to determine what the money could be spent on within the nursery (such as books, equipment, trips) which would specifically support that child and enhance their nursery experience.
